Henry C. "Hank" Raymonds

Henry C. "Hank" Raymonds began his coaching career at Christian Brothers College (now University) in St. Louis, Mo. from 1955-1961. From there he became Marquette University's Assistant Men's Basketball coach under Eddie Hickey, then Al McGuire from 1961-1977. He became Marquette's Head Coach, compiling a 126-60 record from 1977 through 1983. He served as Athletic Director from 1977-1987 at MU and was responsible for elevating the women's athletic teams to Division I status in 1985. In his career as a head coach he compiled a 236-100 record, led two NCAA tournament teams, and coached seventeen NBA draft picks.

Beyond the basketball court, Coach Raymonds is known as a man of faith and commitment. He is dedicated to his family, his student athletes, and his community. Inspired by the dedication and loyalty of his players to their coach, an anonymous donor at Christian Brothers University initiated the *Hank Raymonds Endowed Scholarship* for men's basketball. At his retirement ceremony in 1987, Raymonds was presented with, and then returned, a gift of \$10,000 from MU, requesting that it be used to lay the foundation for the Blue and Gold Fund that continues to support non-revenue sports at the University to this day.

His former players offer that he placed an emphasis on 'student' athletes. It was Coach Raymonds who guided them on and off the court, helping them to excel in the pursuit of their education and athletic achievement. In the process, coach taught them to be caring individuals.

Hank has been married to Jinny for 58 years and they have 5 adult children and numerous grand and great-grandchildren. Coach Raymonds has received many honors throughout his career including induction into the Marquette, Saint Louis and Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Halls of Fame. He has also served on the Board of Directors for Hoops for Hope, a retreat, basketball and nature camp for inner city youth.

Anthony M. Kuchan, Ph.D.

Anthony M. Kuchan, Ph.D., is a past board member of the Father Danihy Alumni Club of Alpha Sigma Nu and served as its president from 1996-2003. He is a licensed psychologist and retired professor emeritus from Marquette University. He is a founding faculty member and core faculty professor of the Wisconsin School of Professional Psychology, and chaired Marquette University's Department of Psychology (1977-1987).

Dr. Kuchan is well-published and has received many honors and awards throughout his career including the Wisconsin Psychological Association's Distinguished Professional Service Award (1984), the MU Department of Psychology Outstanding Teacher Award (1992), and the University Pere Marquette Teaching Award (1994).

He has been a member of the Milwaukee Archdiocesan Review Board since 2003. Dr. Kuchan served as a member and chair of the Milwaukee Archbishop's Commission of Priest Sexual Abuse to review the handling of abuse allegations. The Commission developed a procedure to address the concerns of both the clergy and the victim-survivors.

Dr. Kuchan is highly regarded by generations of Psychology Department undergraduate and graduate students and has deep respect from fellow faculty. As a psychologist and in his volunteer work, his expert ability to facilitate group conversation, listen, and ask deeply insightful and moving questions are counted as valued gifts. Among his numerous volunteer contributions, Tony together with Martha, his wife of 56 years, provided leadership for the Campus Ministry marriage preparation program for 26 years as facilitators for retreats that served more than 500 engaged couples. Tony & Martha have 5 children, 11 grandchildren and their first great-grandchild.

Professionally, his practice has included decades of work with adolescent boys at St. Charles Home for Boys, making a difference in the lives of many, one boy at a time.
