What is Alpha Sigma Nu?

Alpha Sigma Nu is the Jesuit Honor Society and the highest honor bestowed on a Jesuit campus. AΣN is unique among honor societies in that it seeks to identify students of Jesuit institutions who demonstrate exceptional commitment to the AΣN tenets of scholarship, loyalty to Jesuit ideals, and service to campus and community.

Who is eligible to apply?

Juniors, seniors and graduate students who rank academically in the top 15% of their class and have a demonstrated record of service and loyalty to the Jesuit ideals are eligible to apply. Your school will send you an invitation to apply letter if you meet the criteria. Only 4% of each class may be inducted.

What are the benefits?

- AΣN scholarships at each member institution
- Involvement in Jesuit mission-focused activities and a unique connection to the Jesuits
- Lifelong membership and networking with a remarkable group of Jesuit-educated people from the U.S., Canada, South Korea, and Spain
- Access to the online member directory of 80,000+ Alpha Sigma Nu members
- Membership in one of 10 Alpha Sigma Nu Alumni Clubs upon graduation
- Eligibility to apply for AΣN's Seelos Grants, student aid for Ignatian leadership training, social justice conferences, Jesuit networking, etc
- Entrance at the GS-7 level in numerous professional and technical occupations in the
- Federal service
- Through partnerships with the Washington Internship Institute, The Fund for American
- Studies, and The Washington Center of Internships, members of each ACHS member society may qualify for scholarships

What is the cost?

The one-time cost of \$70 covers your certificate, engraved member pin/pendant, and lifetime membership. While there are no annual dues, many members continue to support Alpha Sigma Nu through donations to the annual Sustaining Fund.
