THE POWER OF THE PLEDGE

Felt in chapels from Loyola Marymount to Boston College, from Campion to Spring Hill, a great hope and a sense of the possible emanate in the room when new inductees, led by Chapter presidents, stand and recite the Alpha Sigma Nu pledge. These new members promise "to do all this in light of the Jesuit concern for the greater glory of God," pledging to use their intellect, experience, and heart in the service of faith and the promotion of justice.

When did you make your pledge? As the mission of Jesuit education has evolved over $A\Sigma N$'s 100 years, the pledge's focus has moved from an internal, campus focus to a wider commitment to caring for local and global communities. Early on, members pledged service to the university, promising "no fraternal interests or campus politics" would interfere with meeting their responsibilities as members. Later, members "promised to do all in my power - both now and in my subsequent career - to carry out the ideals ... "

All versions have the essential pledge to scholarship, loyalty, and service over a lifetime with an emphasis on serving others. The pledge binds us all in heeding the call of St. Ignatius. As Pope Francis explained in 2013:

"In following what St. Ignatius teaches us, the main element ... is to learn to be magnanimous. What does being magnanimous mean? It means having a great heart, having greatness of mind; it means having great ideals, the wish to do great things to respond to what God asks of us."





The foundation of the $A\Sigma N$ pledge is found in the mission of the Society of Jesus, "a mission rooted in the belief that a new world of justice, love and peace needs educated persons of competence, conscience and compassion... dedicated to the reform of society and its

structures." Today, the Jesuits look to all of us to be collaborators, not only because of their declining numbers but because of a renewed theological vision of mutuality and partnership with the people of God.

There is no better way to celebrate the Alpha Sigma Nu Centennial than to renew your pledge. The pledge is a challenge to ask these guestions: How will I bear the name Jesuit? How will I collaborate? As Pope Francis might ask, how will I be magnanimous?

ALUMNI VOICES MEMBER STORIES THROUGH THE DECADES

Katherine A. Samuel (Scranton `10)

My favorite memory was the opportunity to work at an after school project in low-income housing during my time in AΣN. After, I worked in Harlem as a special education teacher. I used my experience to inform my daily work and instruction.

Robert J. Nikolai, PhD (Saint Louis `04) Honorary Inductee My father became a member of Alpha Sigma Tau at Creighton University in May 1923. I have his membership certificate (and it is framed with mine).

Elizabeth G. Wylie, PhD (Seattle `79) Honorary Inductee

I became an honorary member of the Seattle University Chapter in 1979 after being asked to speak to a group of Alpha Sigma Nu students. I have remained, over the years, interested in Alpha Sigma Nu's scholarship programs. Above all else, education of our youngsters is the key to our futures.

John Plunkett (Loyola Maryland `48)

I recall the phone call from **Ev Moen** (Marquette `30) newly elected $A\Sigma N$ president, asking to meet for lunch so I could hear his plans for $A\Sigma N$. They were ambitious. Ev arranged for a tax deduction for donations and the merger with Gamma Pi Epsilon. Some of the men protested that women are smarter than men and would soon outnumber them. From the pictures, it looks like about 10 to 5. I was secretary for all of my time on the Board, and the first trip to Milwaukee was my first plane ride.

R. T. Ament (Creighton `60)

During my second year at Creighton, the Dean of the Business College stopped me and asked if I would accept a nomination to A∑N. I wasn't sure what it meant, but when I told my roommate he just said, "Wow!!" I had to borrow money from him for the initiation fee - a very proud moment in my life

Joseph Glas, PhD (Rockhurst `58)

Our daughter, **Dr. Mary Glas Gaspers** (Saint Joseph's `97) and her husband **Mark Gaspers** (Loyola Marymount `98) have three prospects, ages 6, 4, and 2 for third generation AΣNers.

Sijoo Han (Sogang `15)

Sogang A Σ N held a "Jesuit Week Quiz Event" last autumn. The quiz was about the philosophy of the Jesuits and the great achievement that Jesuit priests have made. All students in Sogang could participate, and the winner got a prize. As a main MC of the event, I felt honored to let more people know about the Jesuits and A Σ N.

Robin Panlener (Marquette `68)

The morning of our acceptance into AΣN, I entered the room at Marquette's Brooks Memorial Union and saw I was the first to arrive. Soon after, another man appeared, **Vince Lombardi** (Marquette '68), coach of the Green Bay Packers. Shortly thereafter, my father, **Richard J. Panlener** (Marquette '33) entered, and I had the privilege of introducing Vince Lombardi to him. It was a special day.

At the University of San Francisco in 1958, the Rev. Paul Harney, Academic VP, used our AΣN Chapter as a student advisory board. What improvements did we want to see? One of our first recommendations was an expensive one. We told him that the main Liberal Arts building was a hideous pink color and an embarrassment to everyone.

As President of the AΣN Scranton Alumni Club, I spoke at the ceremony for new inductees. Slated to speak after the student officers, I remember being humbled by the evidence of their scholarship, loyalty, and service and that of the new inductees. I am honored to be a member. A copy of the pledge is on my desk at work where I renew it daily and pray that I live up to it with actions.

Michael T. Kucharski (Loyola Chicago `89)

At the time of my nomination I was only concerned about making more money. Upon induction I found the value of leading by serving. This leadership servant value served me well in my professional and personal life. A Σ N established my values in life for the future.

When Alpha Sigma Nu founded the Chapter of the Year Award, the purpose was twofold – to set expectations providing motivation for Chapter action and to reward the Chapter whose programming best embodies the tenets of scholarship, loyalty, and service in meaningful and innovative ways. Today we see an added bonus...Chapters outlining their programs enables all $A\Sigma N$ members to hear about the creativity, commitment, and generosity of today's Chapter members.

Congratulations to the Fordham University Alpha Sigma Nu Chapter, the 2014-15 Chapter of the Year. Led by officers **Rachel Mae Aguilar** (Fordham '14), **Michael Charboneau** (Fordham '14), **Elizabeth Stevenson** (Fordham '14), and **Gianna Sciangula** (Fordham '14), the Fordham Chapter set this goal at their first

meeting: To build stronger awareness of A Σ N while serving the community and interfacing with other campus organizations and those in the community. They then asked **Philip Florio, SJ** (Fordham '12), to launch the school year with a discussion on how to best take advantage of Fordham's curriculum in their senior year and how to apply Jesuit teaching to their post-graduate life.

The Chapter's projects were diverse and focused on $A\Sigma N$ tenets. Members collaborated with the Fordham Club for the Haunted House with P.O.T.S., a 'onestop shop' helping low-income individuals and families in the Bronx move from crisis to self-sufficiency. Another Bronx-area

effort found AΣN members supervising boys of the Crotona program (an after school program for boys) at St. Rose's Garden, a local community garden.

They joined forces with Fordham's Circle-K chapter for Thanksgiving Dinner at Rose Hill Apartments, preparing Thanksgiving dinner to residents at a Bronx low-income retirement home. Christmas time found the Chapter and the Fordham Choir at Murray-Weigel, Fordham's retired Jesuit nursing home. The choir

caroled while A Σ N provided baked goods and company to the retired Jesuits. The visit was so successful they returned in the spring for a campus walk with the Jesuits for more great conversation.

"Our members are the reason why our Chapter has been so successful this year. Attendees were fully engaged at the events, whether it was asking inquisitive questions at a networking panel, or playing with kids at a haunted house. Members benefited in different ways at each event - from learning how to market their Jesuit education to feeling like they helped bridge the gap between the Fordham community and Bronx families," explained Chapter President Rachel Aguilar.

Other programs included the first annual Fordham-wide Kan Jam Tournament benefitting a local charity; working at the food pantry at Lincoln Center's St. Paul the Apostle; coordinating the Alumni Networking Panel with $\Delta\Sigma$ N's NYC Alumni Club, and working with Counseling and Psychological Services during Mental Health Awareness Week. When $\Delta\Sigma$ N members delivered ' $\Delta\Sigma$ N Milk and Cookies' late at night during finals, their fellow students' faces lit up

as peers encouraged peers to study hard.

A panel of $A\Sigma N$ Board members and staff determined the Chapter of the Year winner. "Three things stood out for me in the Fordham application," said panelist **Patrick Cain** (Loyola Marymount '77), $A\Sigma N$'s Board president. "First, they seem to pay special attention to developing cohesiveness as a group. Secondly, they had an array of service projects that really got the students out into the community. And the Chapter events placed a special focus on relations with the Jesuit community."

The Award came at just the right time for Faculty Adviser **Rosemary DeJulio**, **PhD** (Fordham '07), "After being Faculty Adviser for close to a decade and about to retire and pass the baton, it was a wonderful and most grateful capstone to

> my 36 year career at Fordham. Moreover, though, it was a fitting tribute to a Chapter who has exponentially increased, not only awareness of $A\Sigma N$ on campus, but also the degree and diversity of the projects undertaken and adopted over subsequent years. Truly, the e-boards I have had the privilege to serve with have inspired members to do more and to be more - and became living examples of what it means to be men and women for others."

"Thanks to the undying support

of our adviser, the groundwork of past e-boards, and the meaningful mission of Alpha Sigma Nu, many people and groups were excited to collaborate with us. Our Chapter is as strong as it is today because of years of fostering relationships with local service groups, spreading the word about A Σ N's mission, and producing quality events." 
