President's update



Dear Members,

This has been a year of great celebration and success for Alpha Sigma Nu. At the Triennial Conference at Regis University in October 2003, representatives and Faculty Advisers of Chapters and delegates from Alumni Clubs came together for a terrific meeting. At the Triennial we adopted major revisions to our Bylaws, inaugurated the "Chartering" of nine (9) Alumni Clubs, created a new committee, and

Clubs, created a new committee, and elected new board members and officers. We also announced that Kate Gaertner had been selected as the new full time Executive Director of $A\Sigma N$, effective upon Peg Fennig's retirement at the end of June 2004.

This has been a year of significant records for our Society: Our Chapters inducted an all time high of 1,669 new members. Our Sustaining Fund received an unprecedented \$152,273 in donations, more than ever before. This tells us that you like what we are doing. And it allows $A\Sigma N$ to do more. To further strengthen $A\Sigma N$, we will soon accept electronic contributions and gifts of stock as well as bequests through your trusts and wills. These methods make it easier for you to support our Society's initiatives.

Our new Board has met twice this year. In response to the Triennial's challenge to help Alumni Clubs and Chapters continue adult formation in Jesuit Values, the Board met immediately after the Triennial and created an Ongoing Formation Committee. This Committee has been meeting regularly, and you should expect its report shortly. The Board met a second time in April 2004 at Marquette University in Milwaukee, attending the Marquette Chapter induction and honoring the decade-long service of Peg Fennig, our wonderful Executive Director. In her honor, we created the Peg Fennig Award to be awarded at Triennial Conferences to a member who has contributed to the vitality of ASN.



The goal: to assist members in discovering, experiencing and embodying Ignatian spirituality in their relationships, leadership, service and theological growth.

The Ongoing Formation Committee is chaired by Thomas Franks, OFM, (Fordham '02) and has as its members Sarah Doherty (Xavier '03), Gilles Mongeau, SJ, (Gonzaga '89), John Pustejovsky (Marquette '75), Judy Talvacchia (Weston '96) and Andrea Zardetto-Smith (Loyola Chicago '85).

Chapter highlights

Canisius continues its service with a benefit concert for a school in Afghanistan and its annual Christmas Party for refugee children. This active group also participated in a Community Clean-up. Creighton welcomed 55 new inductees to the student Chapter with a dinner in their honor. That evening, the Chapter presented the Annual AΣN National Book Award to Ruth Purtilo from the Center for Health Policy and Ethics, and Amy Haddad, (Creighton '95) from the School of Pharmacy and Health Professions, for their volume Health Professional and Patient Interaction. Fairfield students collect Christmas gifts for homeless children and work with Prospect House and Merton House. LeMovne members volunteered at the Rescue Mission in addition to entering a team in the Heart Walk benefiting the American Heart Association. Loyola in Maryland annually presents a Teacher of the Year Award. Loyola New Orleans members collaborated with the school's Community Action Program to accompany senior citizens to the Loyola Ballet performance in April. The Chapter created a hand made ornament for the University's Christmas tree.

Scranton's induction speaker, Frank McDonnell, Esq., chair of the University Board of Trustees, was the A Σ N student president in 1960. Scranton also inducted the local bishop. They have an eight-person advisory Board to assist the Chapter. St. Louis awards the Outstanding Faculty Award annually. Spring Hill raised funds for a child who has cancer. University of Detroit Mercy Faculty Adviser, Gail Burnett, (Detroit Mercy '93) was awarded a Mission Effectiveness Award with her A Σ N activities cited. Sustaining Fund success

The Sustaining Fund soared this year, netting \$152,273, an increase of \$13,004 over last year's record. The number of donors increased to 2,926, and the average gift went up to \$51.36. All of the member schools were represented with Marquette, St. Louis and Loyola Chicago leading in sheer numbers of donors. Young alumni contributed generously again this year. We see these donations as the building blocks for future $\Delta\Sigma N$ services and programming.


