Alpha Sigma Nu | Jesuit Honor Society

What is Alpha Sigma Nu?

Alpha Sigma Nu is the only honor society permitted to bear the name *Jesuit* and is the highest honor bestowed on a Jesuit campus. ΑΣΝ is unique among honor societies in that it seeks to identify students of Jesuit universities who not only demonstrate excellence in academics but also an exceptional commitment to the ΑΣΝ tenets of loyalty to Jesuit ideals and service to campus and community.

Who is eligible to apply?

Juniors, seniors and graduate students who rank academically in the top 15% of their class and have a demonstrated record of service and loyalty to the Jesuit ideals are eligible to apply. Your school will send you an invitation to apply letter if you meet the criteria. Only 4% of each class may be accepted and inducted.

What are the benefits?

- ΑΣΝ scholarships at each member institution
- ΑΣΝ Seelos Grants to fund student member attendance at a variety of Ignatian justice, leadership, and service experiences
- Involvement in Jesuit mission focused activities and a unique connection to the Jesuits
- Lifelong membership and ongoing resources to connect you to the Jesuit mission
- Networking and access through the online member directory to 90,000+ Alpha Sigma Nu members living across the world
- Invitation to join local Alpha Sigma Nu Alumni Club after graduation
- Invitation to member-exclusive webinars, lectures, etc.
- Entrance at the GS-7 level in numerous professional and technical occupations in the Federal Service
- As an accredited member of ACHS, ΑΣΝ members may qualify for scholarships

What is the cost?

The one-time cost of \$70 covers your certificate, engraved member pin/pendant, and lifetime membership. Local fees may also be applied. While there are no annual dues, many members continue to support Alpha Sigma Nu through donations to the annual Sustaining Fund.
